Atascocita Landfill Summer 2024

MANAGER'S REPORT

The summer months are here, and we're preparing for another hot season at the landfill. Operations have remained steady through the first half of the year, and several upcoming projects are planned.



Construction on the new 11-acre cell was recently completed, and we

have already begun filling it with trash. We also finished seeding the slopes on the south side of the landfill.

Our upcoming projects include installing approximately 28 gas wells. These wells, a testament to our commitment to environmental responsibility, will extract landfill gas and convert it to natural gas, which is pushed directly into the natural gas pipeline, providing a sustainable energy source for communities. We will also be redrilling six wells to improve gas quality. Our gas wells are important and beneficial as they decrease our environmental impact and help reduce potential odors.

We have been actively involved in the community this Spring, demonstrating our commitment to the local area. Once again, we were proud sponsors of the Humble Good Oil Days Festival in downtown Humble. The landfill also provided lunch for all the teachers and employees at Park Lakes Elementary during Teacher Appreciation Week in May. Additionally, we supported the Humble ISD Education Foundation by volunteering on their grant selection committee.

As the summer months heat up, it's crucial to reiterate the importance of staying hydrated to help avoid heat stress. When working outside, consuming 32 ounces of water per hour is recommended. Avoid drinks with excess caffeine, sugar, or alcohol. Work in the shade when possible and wear a wide-brimmed hat for protection from the sun.

WM BEGINS CONSTRUCTION ON A NEW HAULING SITE IN ATASCOCITA

WM of Texas, Inc. is currently constructing a new hauling site in Atascocita. WM Atascocita Hauling, located on Atascocita Road, just a few miles from Atascocita Landfill, is slated to open in early 2025.

As part of our strategic growth plan, WM's Houston Metro hauling site at 10701 Todd Road and 1901 Afton Road will close and relocate to a new, larger site in the Lake Houston area. This move is about expanding our operations and positioning ourselves for future growth in the region. WM will develop 27 acres of the 64-acre site, including a 42,500-square-foot maintenance shop, 18,686-square-foot office, and 27,500-square-foot container shop.

The hauling district will be home to more than 170 trucks running 142 routes. The maintenance shop will employ 47 employees, and the new office space will also serve as the WM Texas Oklahoma market area headquarters. Approximately 25 employees will work there full-time, with 114 employees utilizing the office space on a hybrid schedule.
