## Atascocita Landfill Winter 2024

### MANAGER'S REPORT

The winter months are upon us, and we are grateful for the cooler temperatures. We have had a busy fall at the landfill and have several updates for our neighbors.

District Manager Jessica Bivone has recently taken a position to manage another WM landfill in the Houston area. As the Area Manager, I will manage the site until a successor is named. We wish Jessica all the best in her new role and look forward to welcoming a new landfill manager at the beginning of the year.

At the beginning of December, we started a gas capture construction project, which will result in 32 new gas wells

installed once completed. This project will allow us to capture more gas throughout the landfill, further reducing greenhouse emissions while helping reduce potential odors. The captured gas will be converted to natural gas and go directly into the natural gas pipeline, providing a sustainable energy source for communities.

We are also working to clean up slopes with plans to seed in the near future, further beautifying our footprint. Looking ahead to the new year, we are planning to begin an 11-acre cell construction project in early 2025.
